### **Responsibilities:**

- Quality Culture – Responsible to take the leadership role in implementing/maintaining the quality culture directives set forth by the Quality Manager. Acts as champion of quality throughout the department.
- Quality Improvement – Receive, implement, facilitate and participate in quality improvement initiatives set forth by the Quality Manager.
- Quality Conformance – Responsible for ensuring that all raw materials and fabricated product conforms to quality standards. Provides support and recommendations on adjustments required for in-process production.
- Supervision – Provide leadership, direction, and management for Quality team. Ensures conformance with departmental objectives. Mentor team members and peers from other departments.
- Decision Making – Ensures that fabricated product conforms with the outlined quality directives, and ensures quality team members are trained to and working within outlined quality directives.
- Assembles and/or directs information for the preparation of reports.
- Will serve as a liaison between the shop floor and engineering, to communicate any quality issues and facilitate design changes.
- Provides advise, counsel and technical training to Weld Quality Assurance team.
- Manages and approves time for team members for Beam Shop and TAC Facilities.
- Very strong people skills are required to develop improvement teams, and to work independently, across various disciplines. Will work with minimal supervision.
- Responsible for motivating and generating teamwork within teams.
- Coordinates plans to ensure an effective flow of work between departments.
- Educates personnel in the quality philosophy and practices to include improvement strategies.
- Coordinates the workflow of the Quality Assurance Department staff to ensure the efficient and timely processing of materials and information.
